McQueen, Independent candidate, AR-04, endorsed by Citizen's Coalition for Democratization [Candidates With a Contract]

ARKANSAS--Lee McQueen remains the longest-standing challenger to incumbent Republican Bruce Westerman for Arkansas's 4th District House seat since her early entry into the race on 09/28/2017.

On 03/22/2018, McQueen signed a Candidate Contract with Citizen's Coalition for Democratization, signaling her agreement that, if she wins the District 4 House seat, she will legislate for (1) fair elections, (2) anti-corruption, as well as (3) transparency & accountability. In other words, she will represent the people of her district.

According to Candidates With a Contract requirements, her Independent status, and her own Future Arkansas platform, McQueen's priority is to the constituents of District 4 and not to PAC bundlers, corporate donors, industry lobbyists, party operatives, party leaders, etc.

Per CWAC, "Lee is a strong supporter of single-payer healthcare, public education, and government and corporate reforms that lift the voices and wages of regular people."

In response, McQueen says, "Thank you to Candidates With a Contract for providing a necessary blueprint of the proper role for a candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives. I am very pleased to be one of a full wave of progressive congressional candidates name-checked for responsible and accountable politics. It is time to reverse Citizens United. Money is not speech. Corporations are not people. People are not animals. We deserve better."
